Last Week's Highlights:

- The Soldotna High School track and field program competed at the KPBSD Borough Championships on Saturday, May 13th at Justin Maile Field. Both the boys and girls programs captured the overall team title. Top individual performances from the SOHI boys included Brenner Furlong (2nd in the 200 M and 1st in the 400 M), Lance Chilton (1st in the 3200 M), Sean Vergin (2nd in the 3200 M), Josh Shuler (3rd in the 3200 M), Abraham Van Hout (1st in the 110 M and 300 M hurdles), Wendell Tuisaula (1st in the shot put and discus), Kyle Marcuson (2nd in the shot put), Logan Schrader (2nd in the long jump and triple jump), and Bechler Metcalf (3rd in the triple jump). The boys also won the 400 M, 800 M, and 3200 M relay events. For the Soldotna girls, top individual performers included Brittany Taylor (2nd in the 200 M), Kellie Arthur (2nd in the 800 M and 1st in the 3200 M), Sophie Thomas (2nd in the 100 M and 300 M hurdles), Itua Tuisaula (1st in the shot put), Annie Quinn (2nd in the shot put and discus), Emily Pieh (3rd in the discus), Aliann Schmidt (1st in the high jump), Danica Schmidt (2nd in the high jump), Olivia Schwenk (3rd in the high jump), Kylie Ness (3rd in the long jump), and Denali Wurst (3rd in the triple jump). The girls 1600 M relay team also took home the title.
- The SOHI girls soccer team enjoyed a strong showing last week, picking up three crucial wins. On Tuesday, Abi Tuttle scored the lone goal as the Stars defeated Nikiski 1-0. On Friday, SOHI traveled to Houston and picked up a big 7-0 win over the Hawks. The Stars received goals from Abi Tuttle (2), Cameron Blackwell (2), Meijan Leaf, Whitney Wortham, and Journey Miller. Soldotna wrapped up its regular season with 1-0 victory over host Grace Christian on Saturday. Abi Tuttle was the lone goal scorer in the game. Incredibly, goalie Ella Stenga has not given up a goal in three straight games. SOHI heads to Regions with a 10-5 overall record (3-1 in conference).
- The SOHI boys soccer picked up two big wins this past weekend. On Friday, the Stars defeated Houston 11-1. Both Alex Montague and Luke Trammell earned hat tricks (3 goals apiece) for the visiting Stars. SOHI also received goals from Eli Sheridan, Ben Godfrey, Gavin Goggia, Sean McMullen, and Braden Lemm. On Saturday, Soldotna picked up another win by defeating host Grace Christian 5-4. Once again, Alex Montague scored a hat trick. SOHI also got goals from Brayden Van Meter and Luke Trammell. Eli Sheridan also had three assists in the game. Soldotna finishes the regular season with an 8-7 overall record (2-2 in conference).
- The SOHI baseball team earned a walk-off victory over the visiting Colony Knights on Tuesday, May 9th. Down 4-5 in the 7th inning, SOHI tied the game on a bunt single from Joel Sisson. Sophomore David Michael was then able to come up with a huge single up the middle of the infield, scoring Caleb Spence and giving SOHI a 6-5 win. Michael was 2 for 4 with 2 RBIs in the game. Austin Asp earned the victory, going two scoreless innings and only allowing one hit. Soldotna is now 5-5 on the season (4-2 in conference).
- The SOHI softball team picked up two dominating wins on Wednesday night, defeating Houston 17-5 and 45-0 in doubleheader action. Pitcher Danielle Hills picked up two wins on the day and also went 4 for 7 with 6 RBIs in the second game. The Stars also received big performances from Ember Lohrke (4 for 4 with 4 RBIs and 3 walks) and Bailey Berger (4 for 5) in the second game. In the first game, SOHI was led by Jazi Larrow (2 for 2 with 2 walks), Darcy Blume (2 for 4 with a triple and 2 RBIs), and Lohrke (2 for 4 with a triple). Soldotna is now 5-2 on the season (5-1 in conference).
