Last Week's Highlights:

- The Soldotna High School track and field program competed at the Region III championships this past weekend in Homer. The boys finished 3rd overall in the 4A team standings. Top individual performers included Brenner Furlong (3rd in the 200M and 1st in the 400M), Koby Vinson (3rd in the 400M), Abraham Van Hout (1st in the 110M hurdles and 300M hurdles), and Wendell Tuisaula (1st in the discus and shot put). The 800M and 1600M relay teams also took home championships. The SOHI girls finished 4th overall in the 4A team standings. Top individual performers for the Stars included Brittany Taylor (3rd in the 200M and 400M), Kylie Ness (3rd in the 100M hurdles), Sophie Thomas (3rd in the 300M hurdles), Ituuu Tuisaula (2nd in the shot put), Annie Quinn (3rd in the shot put), Emily Pieh (3rd in the discus), and Aliann Schmidt (tied for 2nd in the high jump).
- The SOHI girls soccer team picked up an opening round victory over Houston (2-0) on Thursday at the NLC Tournament Championship at Colony High School. The Stars picked up goals from Abi Tuttle and Meijan Leaf. After a semifinal loss on Friday, SOHI battled Kenai in an epic 3rd place game. Tied 2-2 at the end of regulation, both SOHI and Kenai were able to score goals in the overtime periods. This led to a five-shot round of penalty kicks, which resulted in a tie. Ultimately, a sudden-death round of PKs resulted in a Kenai victory. Despite the loss, Soldotna enjoyed a successful season, finishing 11-7 overall. Abi Tuttle was named NLC first team, while Ryann Cannava and Journey Miller were both selected to the second team.
- The SOHI boys soccer team started the NLC tournament with a big 4-1 victory over Grace Christian. SOHI was led by the play of Eli Sheridan (2 goals), Luke Trammell (1 goal) and Brayden Van Meter (1 goal). The Stars also received a strong game in goal from Chase Miller. The Stars would go on to lose to the eventual champions Kenai in the semifinals, and then lost a hard fought 2-1 game against Homer on Saturday. Soldotna finishes the season with a 9-9 record. Eli Sheridan and Alex Montague were named to the NLC first team, while Addison Downing was selected to the second team.
- The SOHI baseball team earned two big conference victories last week, defeating Kenai 6-0 on Wednesday and Kodiak 4-2 on Thursday. In the Kenai game, SOHI received a spectacular pitching performance from senior Matthew Daugherty, who finished the game surrendering 0 hits and striking out 11. Offensively, the Stars were led by Caleb Spence, who finished 2 for 3 with two runs scored and an RBI. In Thursday's game, Austin Asp picked up the win, pitching 5 scoreless innings and striking out 6 while only giving up 2 hits. The Stars picked up RBIs from Jeremy Kupferschmid, Logan Smith and Terrance Slats. Cody Quelland also stole home for a crucial run in the 6th inning. Soldotna finishes the regular season with a 7-7 overall record (6-4 in conference).
- The SOHI softball team picked up a huge 16-4 conference win Wednesday afternoon against the visiting Kenai Cardinals. The Stars received a dominating pitching performance from Danielle Hills, who threw a no hitter and struck out 8. Soldotna also enjoyed a balanced scoring attack picking up RBIs from Ember Lohrke, Ashley McDonald, Taylor Earll, Carlin Meyer, and Hills. SOHI finishes the regular season with a record of 6-3 overall (6-2 in the conference). They will be the #2 seed in the inaugural Region III softball tournament in Homer this weekend.
