LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

- The Soldotna volleyball team punched their ticket to state by finishing second at the NLC tournament this past weekend in Kodiak. After sweeping Kenai in the first round, SOHI lost to Wasilla in the semifinals on Thursday night. However, the Stars battled their way back up through the loser's bracket, defeating Kodiak (3-2) and Palmer (3-1) on Friday to clinch a spot at state. On Saturday, SOHI was able to avenge their loss on Thursday to Wasilla by defeating the Warriors 3-1. The Stars were led by the play of Ella Stenga (8 service points, 6 kills, 17 digs, and 4 blocks), Kodi McGillivray (10 service points and 3 kills), Shay Zener (14 service points, 5 kills and 12 digs), Aliann Schmidt (12 kills and 5 blocks), Bailey Leach (12 service points, 9 kills and 2 blocks), Holleigh Jaime (17 service points and 19 digs), and Cally Christianson (9 service points, 32 assists and 1 block). The win propelled SOHI into a championship match-up with Colony. Ultimately, the Knights would prevail with a back-and-forth 3-2 victory. Ella Stenga and Shay Zener were both named to the all-region 1st team. Kalyn McGillivray was selected as Soldotna's good sport team member. Soldotna's record now stands at 12-7 (6-4 in conference).
- The Soldotna swim team was well represented at the state championships this past weekend at Bartlett High School. In the team scores, SOHI girls finished 6th overall while the boys finished in 18th. Sydney Juliussen led all Soldotna swimmers, finishing a close second in the 50-yard freestyle race. Other top finishers included the girls 400 yard freestyle relay team and Kylin Welch (4th in the 1 meter diving event).
- The Soldotna High School wrestling program competed in the Colony Invitational this past weekend. The Stars finished 4th in the team standings and were led by the individual performances of Gideon Hutchison (1st – 120 lbs), Logan Craig (2nd – 106 lbs), Dennis Taylor (2nd – 138 lbs), Brenner Furlong (2nd – 182 lbs), Bechler Metcalf (3rd – 152 lbs), Eli Floyd (3rd – 220 lbs), and Hudson Metcalf (4th – 170 lbs).
- The SOHI hockey team got their season underway at the annual Peninsula Ice Challenge at the Soldotna Sports Center. Despite not picking up a win, the Stars showed tremendous fight for a team that features 0 seniors and only 2 juniors. Soldotna received strong performances from Corbin Wirz (49 saves in Thursday's game and 33 saves in Saturday's game), MacKenzie Powell (29 saves in Friday's game), Galen Brantley III (2 goals and 1 assist), Alex Montague (2 goals), and Lucas Kline (blocked 8 shots from his defenseman position in Friday's game).

From November 1st to the 20th we will be hosting a **food drive** in order to help feed families in our community.
