### **LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS**

- The Soldotna High School football team won their 6<sup>th</sup> straight state championship and 59<sup>th</sup> consecutive game with a stifling defensive effort, defeating the Palmer Moose 21-0 on Saturday. Offensively, the Stars were led by senior Brenner Furlong who rushed for 109 yards and a touchdown, and sophomore Aaron Faletoi who rushed 16 times for 64 yards and 1 touchdown. Defensively, SOHI was led by the physical presence of middle linebacker Wendell Tuisauala. The senior made several huge stops and ultimately earned player of the game honors. The Soldotna defensive secondary also came up with some big plays as Jersey Truesdell came away with a key 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter interception and Cody Quelland effectively iced the game with a pick-6 in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Soldotna ends its season with a 10-0 overall record (4-0 in conference) and the nation's second longest active winning streak.
- The Soldotna swim program competed in the Palmer Invite this past weekend. The girls finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the team standings while the boys finished in 8<sup>th</sup>. Top individual performers for the girls included Sydney Juliussen (1<sup>st</sup> in the 50 free), Zeina Aboulkheir (2<sup>nd</sup> in the 500 free), and Portia Padilla (3<sup>rd</sup> in the 100 backstroke). On the boys side, the Stars enjoyed strong performances from Kylin Welch (2<sup>nd</sup> in the 1 meter dive), Sam Skolnick (4<sup>th</sup> in the 1 meter dive), and Will Gross (6<sup>th</sup> in the 100 backstroke).
- The Soldotna High School wrestling program participated in their first meet of the season this past Saturday. The Stars finished second in the team standings at the Luke Spruill Memorial Tournament in Kenai. Top individual performers for SOHI included Logan Craig (1<sup>st</sup> – 113 lbs), Dalten Hulsey (1<sup>st</sup> – 120 lbs), Bechler Metcalf (1<sup>st</sup> – 160 lbs), and Levi Wahl (1<sup>st</sup> – 170 lbs).
- The Soldotna volleyball team battled through a tough series up in the Valley this past weekend. Despite not coming away with a victory in the 3-game set, the Stars showed tremendous grit on numerous occasions, especially on Friday night in Wasilla. Down 0-2 to the Warriors, SOHI battled back to tie the match at 2-2 before eventually losing a close fought 5<sup>th</sup> set 13-15. Coach Kupferschmid was especially proud of the players who stepped up in the absence of senior Ella Stenga who did not play Friday or Saturday due to injury. Kupferschmid specifically noted the efforts of Shay Zener, Cally Christianson, Aliann Schmidt, and Kalyn McGillivray. Soldotna is now 7-5 on the season (5-4 in conference).
