LAST WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

- The Soldotna High School football team won their 56th consecutive game and 12th straight Northern Lights Conference crown on Saturday, prevailing 42-8 over visiting Eagle River. SOHI will be the top seed heading into the Division II state playoffs. Soldotna is now 7-0 on the season (3-0 in conference).
- The Soldotna cross country program had an extremely successful weekend at the Region III Meet in Wasilla, as the boys nearly earned a team championship. The boys finished second overall, falling to first place Wasilla by 2 points. SOHI was led by the performances of Josh Shuler (7th overall), Bradley Walters (9th overall), Koby Vinson (10th overall), Sean Vergin (12th overall), Lance Chilton (15th overall), Bechler Metcalf (17th overall), and John-Mark Pothast (19th overall). Jack Harris also won the JV boys race and was selected as the Region's most outstanding runner. On the girls side, Erika Arthur (14th overall), Kellie Arthur (16th overall), and Cameron Blackwell (18th overall) all enjoyed strong performances. Coach Ted McKenney was also selected as the co-coach of the year for Region III. The SOHI boys varsity team and Erika Arthur will be competing at this weekend's state meet.
- The Soldotna volleyball team swept the season series from Kodiak this past weekend. On Friday, the Stars won 3-1 (25-11, 25-19, 23-25, 25-21) and were led by the play of Ella Stenga (3 kills, 16 digs, 1 block, and 10 service points), Kodi McGillivray (8 kills, 6 digs, 9 aces, and 20 service points) and Shaylynn Zener (11 kills, 19 digs and 14 service points). On Saturday, SOHI saw similar results, defeating the Bears 3-1 (25-19, 25-23, 19-25, and 25-16). The Stars were led by Aliann Schmidt (8 kills and 6 blocks), Holleigh Jaime (23 digs and 7 points), Bailey Leach (2 kills, 1 block, and 6 points), and Cally Christianson (18 service points). Soldotna is now 5-2 on the season (4-1 in conference).
- The Soldotna swim team hosted their annual Pentathlon and Invite this past weekend. The girls finished 2nd overall, led by the individual performances of Sydney Juliussen (3rd overall), Portia Padilla (7th overall), and Zeina Abouelkheir (15th overall). The boys finished 7th

overall, led by the efforts of Ethan Evans (8th overall), Kylin Welch (31st overall), and Will Gross (33rd overall).
