Last Week's Highlights:

- The Northern Lights All-Conference teams were announced last week. Selected to the First Team All-Conference team from the Soldotna Stars was defenseman Corey Hanson. Selected to the Second Team from SOHI was forward Parker Lockwood, defensemen Levi Hensley and goalie Billy Yoder. Forward Galen Brantley III and defensemen Trevor Witthus were selected to the honorable mention team.
- The Soldotna Stars Nordic ski team enjoyed a successful meet at the 7.5K Kenai Peninsula Borough Championships at the Tsalteshi Trails this past Saturday. As a team, the boys' finished first overall and the girls second. Top individual performers for the SOHI boys included Koby Vinson (1st overall – 22:58), Jeremy Kupferschmid (3rd overall), Addison Downing (4th overall), Josh Shuler (6th overall), and Jack Harris (9th overall). On the girls side, top performers for SOHI included Kellie Arthur (9th overall), Cameron Blackwell (10th overall), and Hannah Delker (11th overall).
- The Soldotna Stars boys basketball team defeated Eagle River in dramatic fashion on Friday night in Anchorage 48-46. Tied at 46 with seconds left in overtime, senior Kyle Marcuson hit a fading turnaround jumper from the elbow to secure victory for the Stars. This is the second time Eagle River and the SOHI boys have battled in an overtime game this season (in the first game of the season, the Stars and Wolves played in a classic triple overtime thriller with SOHI prevailing 55-50). Soldotna is now 6-11 on the season (1-5 in conference).
- The SOHI girls JV basketball team competed in a varsity 1A tournament this past weekend in Ninilchik. The Stars finished 2-1, defeating Akiak and host Ninilchik. Due to the tiebreaker system, Soldotna was awarded the second place finish. Denali Wurst, Kianna Holland and Joanna Cornelius were selected to the all-tournament team.
- The SOHI girls' varsity basketball team earned a Maroon Bracket championship at the Dimond Lady Lynx Prep Shootout on Saturday. After losing a heartbreaker on Wednesday (Ketchikan defeated SOHI 37-36 on a 25-foot buzzer beater), the Lady Stars ran the table, defeating Palmer (46-40), West Valley (50-47) and South Anchorage (50-41). In the championship game against South, Ituau Tuisaula (19 points and 13 rebounds) and Aliann Schmidt (13 points and 9 rebounds) led the way for the Stars. Aliann Schmidt and Danica Schmidt were both named to the all-tournament team; Ituau Tuisaula was named the Maroon Bracket's most valuable player (averaged 13 points and over 10 rebounds per game in the tournament). SOHI is now 10-9 on the season (3-3 in conference).
