### Last Week's Highlights:

- The Soldotna Stars football team defeated Kodiak 42-0 on Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup>. SOHI gained 381 yards of offense, 250 of which came on the ground. Brenner Furlong led the Stars with 133 yards rushing and three touchdowns. Quarterback Brandon Crowder also fared well through the air, passing for 131 yards and one touchdown. The Stars are now 6-0 on the season (2-0 in conference) and have won 45 consecutive games.
- The SOHI cross country team had a busy week, competing in the Borough meet in Seward on Tuesday and the Homer Time Trials on Saturday. In the Borough meet, the Stars' boys finished second overall while the girls finished in fourth. Top individual performers included Josh Shuler (9<sup>th</sup> overall in the boys' race), Koby Vinson (10<sup>th</sup> overall in the boys' race), and Kellie Arthur (13<sup>th</sup> overall in the girls' race). Top finishers in the Homer Time Trials for the Stars' boys included Josh Shuler (5<sup>th</sup> overall), Koby Vinson (6<sup>th</sup> overall) and Addison Downing (10<sup>th</sup> overall). On the girls' side, the top finishers for SOHI included Molly Erickson (10<sup>th</sup> overall) and Kellie Arthur (12<sup>th</sup> overall).
- The Soldotna Stars volleyball team had a very successful weekend in the Valley, defeating both Palmer (3-0) and Colony (3-2). Against Palmer, SOHI was led by the play of Judah Aley (13 kills and 14 service points), Shaylynn Zener (30 assists, 6 service points and 2 kills) and Ella Stenga (13 kills and 18 assists). On Saturday, the Stars managed to come back from a 0-2 deficit to defeat the Colony Knights. Judah Aley (22 kills and 4 blocks), Ituu Tuisaula (16 kills and 5 blocks) and Drewe Zeek (14 kills, 4 blocks and 4 assists) led Soldotna to the hard fought victory. SOHI is now 4-1 in conference play and 5-1 on the season in non-tournament play.
