**Last Week's Highlights:**

- The Soldotna Stars football team defeated East Anchorage in an epic 22-21 battle on Saturday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Stars were down 21-14 with 8:52 remaining in the game when they mounted an 18 play, 75 yard drive that consumed 8:04. The drive was punctuated on a 4<sup>th</sup> down touchdown plunge by Austin Schrader. Coach Brantley then put it in the hands of his players, who elected to go for two and the win. Quarterback Brandon Crowder executed a perfect play-action pass to senior tight end Andrew West for the game winning score. The Stars have now won 43 consecutive games and are 4-0 on the season.

- The SoHi cross country team competed in the Palmer Invite on Saturday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The boys finished 9<sup>th</sup> overall, with Josh Shuler finishing with a team best time of 17:25 (31<sup>st</sup> overall). The girls finished 12<sup>th</sup> overall, with Kellie Arthur finishing with a team best time of 21:33 (41<sup>st</sup> overall).
- The Soldotna Stars volleyball team finished third at the Chugiak Invite this past weekend. The tournament featured many of Alaska's premier programs and the Stars demonstrated they belong in the conversation as one of the state's best, finishing an impressive 13-7 in pool play. SoHi defeated East Anchorage in the third place match. Drewe Zeek was named to the all-tournament team.
- The SoHi swim team traveled to Kodiak last weekend. The boys were led by senior Cody Watkins who won the 100 and 200-yard freestyle races. Katie Creglow and Sydney Juliussen were bright spots for the girls team. Juliussen won the 100 freestyle race and finished second in the 200 freestyle. Creglow, a freshman, won the 100 breaststroke.
